  - Enter your email and click password reminder to get your password
  - Complete the assessment
  - Access free risk prevention training and support
  - Email [bcmsupport@supplyrisk.com](mailto:bcmsupport@supplyrisk.com) at any time for website support
- 3) You decide which customers can view which data
- 4) If a disaster occurs near your sites
  - SRS will email you to ask if production is impacted
  - You respond in one-click to many customers

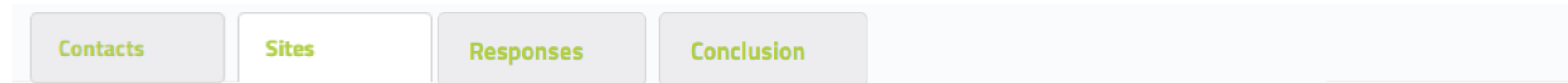

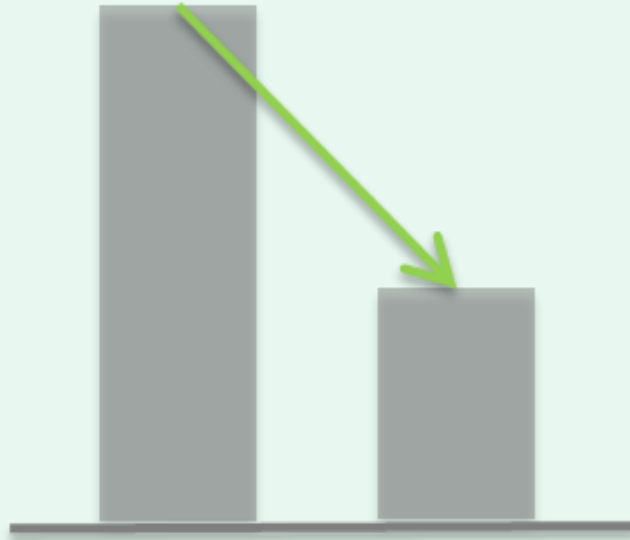
